36 Hour Forecast

Winds:

Today, the winds are forecast to be from the S at 20-25 knots shifting this afternoon to be from the NW at 20-25 knots. Tonight, the winds are expected to be from the N at 25-30 knots. Tuesday, the winds are expected to be from the N at 25-35 knots diminishing after midnight to be from the N at 10-20 knots.

Waves:

Today through Tuesday, near shore seas are predicted to be 4-7 feet.

Precipitation:

Today through Tuesday, showers and/or flurries are forecast in the region.

Ceiling/Visibility:

Today through Tuesday, cloudy skies are predicted. Fog is expected in the region. Visibility is forecast to be 1-3 miles except during periods of fog.

Temperatures:

The temperatures are predicted to range from highs in the upper 40's to lows in the mid 30's.
